## Specification:

Shall be Alluserv Model AURSC \_\_\_\_\_, and shall feature fully welded corrosion-resistant aluminum alloy construction. Vertical uprights of the frame shall be 1"x1" extruded aluminum tubes welded to form a rigid frame. Extruded aluminum universal tray ledges are welded to the vertical uprights. Ledges shall accommodate various sized meal trays, including 14" x 18", 15" x 20" and 16" x 22" and several popular room service trays. The top and bottom of the cart shall be enclosed with a .063 thick aluminum alloy panel. The unit shall have four 5" casters, all-swivel. Two casters shall have brakes. Casters shall have shielded wheel and swivel bearings. Unit shall have a 2-year parts and 1-year labor warranty.

## **Optional Covers:**

Covers shall be of 16-mil clear vinyl and have flap opening on either one or two sides. Flap opening(s) shall have heavy-duty zipper closure.


