

7700 Series Plastic Folding Tables

Table Tops

- Table top is constructed of a one-piece, blowmolded plastic top secured to a steel frame
- Top design features a 1.78" edge
- Durable high density polyethylene tabletop is waterproof, stain resistant, and heat resistant
 - May be used occasionally for outdoor applications, without damage from sun or UV rays
- Table tops supported by an independent 16 gauge steel frame extending the full length of the table
- Additional top support is added by perpendicular
 16 gauge steel cross braces welded to frame
 - o Four braces per rectangular table
 - Two braces per round table
- Tops are secured to frame with heavy-duty machine screws
- Standard table height is 29"

Legs

- 16 gauge by 1 1/8" diameter steel tubing
 - Rectangular tables feature wishbone style legs and two additional perpendicular cross braces
 - Round tables feature "C style" legs with recessed curved cross braces
- Tubing is powder coat painted to match frame
- Horizontal crossbars machine welded to the vertical supports
- Vertical tubing rests on four easily replaceable, non-marking plastic caps
- Locking mechanism is a sliding collar "gravity lock" style, for easy set-up and teardown

Warranty
